

General Anesthetic Information and Consent

Protocol

You will need to bring your child to the St. John Hospital the day before the general anesthetic dental visit for a pre-operative appointment. The doctors will want to check your child to make sure she/he is healthy.

If you are travelling from out of town for your appointment we recommend you stay the night in Vanderhoof as your child will be expected early at the hospital the next day.

The Northern Health Authority requires a questionnaire to be filled out regarding VRE and MRSA during the office consultation. If you have answered yes to any question the hospital may want to check and swab your child for these bacteria.

Financial Obligation

We may not be able to take x-rays or get good cooperation during the patient's visual exam, but you will be given the closest financial estimate for the dental treatment that we can.

We will try to work directly with your insurance company. However, some dental treatment may not be covered by your particular plan, or may have been done previously and will have to be addressed again. Financial limits also apply to many dental plans. Due to privacy considerations we may have difficulty in finding specific details. If the insurance company does not cover a treatment, the responsibility is yours.

During the general anesthetic appointment at the hospital if the dentist sees additional cavities or other problems that were not evident during the office visit or included in the estimate, we will complete this treatment.

I will assume financial responsibility for the dental treatment.
